Performance Notes: The universal message and energetic music make this a perfect choice as an opening or closing to any concert, particularly one featuring mass choir of 2, 3, or 4-part singers. Consider using a very young sounding voice for the solo. A youngster of elementary age would be ideal. Note the gradual crescendo that continues from the beginning to measure 69 and then suddenly, at measure 77, returns us back to the quiet mood of the opening. **E.L.**
